Donna Spencer, CTRI

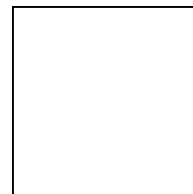

Level 1– Equine Skills

May 31-June 1

This is a 1 1/2 day hands-on workshop that targets therapists with minimal to no horse experience in non-mounted equine skills. Participants will work with horses in teams of 2-3, allowing an opportunity for demonstration, practice and individualized feedback and instruction.*

Objectives: Participants will learn basic horsemanship skills of grooming, tacking, and leading.

Hippotherapy Treatment Principles

June 1– June 3

This 2 1/2 day curriculum, Hippotherapy Treatment Principles Level 1, is designed for entry level therapists utilizing hippotherapy as a treatment strategy, and those interested in or working with hippotherapy teams. Mounted practicum's are available in this course. This course may be attended by physical and occupational therapists, assistants, and speech-language pathologists. Therapeutic riding instructors, administrators, and others interested in the principles of Hippotherapy, although they may not provide hippotherapy services, are encouraged to attend this course with the treating therapist on their team. The curriculum may be utilized only under conditions set by AHA Inc.*

Objectives: Participants will learn basic theories of hippotherapy and how to practice in a hippotherapy setting.
