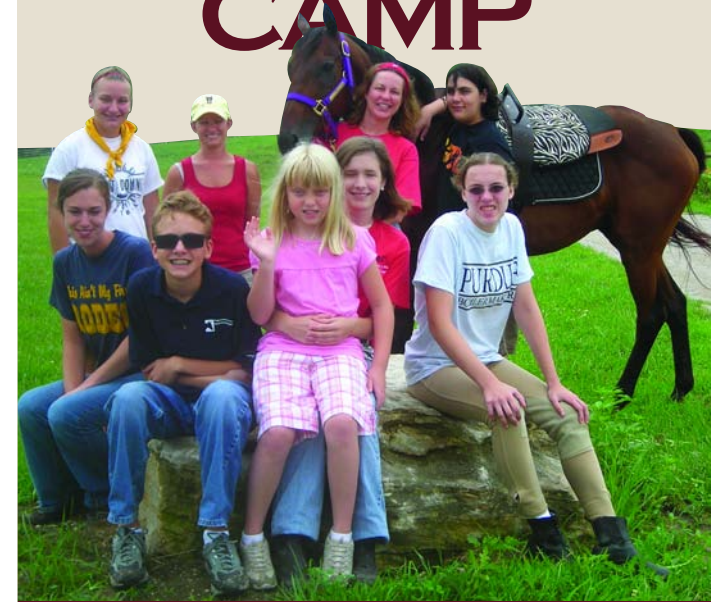

Programs

Camps will include daily riding lessons, vaulting, trail rides, carriage driving, arts and crafts, instruction in horse care and first aid, lectures, games, videos, and much, much more!

Campers will be instructed on position, balance, and safety in the saddle instilling confidence and a foundation for further development.

Therapeutic Horsemanship's state of the art facility is located on 96 rolling acres in the heart of St. Charles County. Our large indoor and outdoor arenas make riding possible rain or shine. TH is considered home to 26 horses and ponies representing numerous different breeds. Our knowledgeable staff and volunteers are committed to making each camper's experience a truly memorable one.

Attire

For each camper's safety, he/she is required to wear jeans or proper riding pants and boots with a heel. TH can provide approved riding helmets. A comfortable and appropriate change of clothes is recommended for afternoon activities. Sandals are not permitted at any time.

Lunch

Each camper needs to bring a sack lunch, snack, and plenty of fluids each day. Carrots and apples are a welcome treat for the horses. A refrigerator and microwave are available.

All camp sessions are \$325 and run from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm daily.

A \$100 deposit is required at registration. The remaining \$225 is due prior to the start of the camp session.
